### METHOD OF PAYMENT:

Payment is due prior to services being rendered. Best Cremation Care accepts VISA, MasterCard, Discover or Certified Check.

### In compliance with the Federal Trade Commission, we offer the following breakdown of our individual prices.

#### A. SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF: \$ 680

The fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the services you select. (This fee is included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.) This fee includes registering the death certificate in the county where the death occurred, permit and sheltering of the decedent in refrigeration until permit is obtained.

- ~ Professional fee for obtaining additional permits \$ 39

#### B. DIRECT CREMATION: \$ 1,100

Includes the removal of the decedent from a medical facility within 30 miles of Best Cremation's contracted crematories, sheltering the decedent in refrigeration, completing a signed death certificate, filing the certificate and permit with the local health department, alternative container, cremation process, and utility urn. If you want to arrange for a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of material like fiberboard. The container which we provide is fiberboard. If the consumer provides a container, the direct cremation is \$1,400. The container must be made of fiberboard or the crematory will have an additional fee of \$300. We are able to provide this service for decedents who weigh up to 250lbs.

If embalming is declined and the final disposition of the deceased is not completed within 24 hours of the time of death, refrigeration is required by California State regulation, Title 16 Sec. 1223(b). Note: Our initial refrigeration fee includes 5 consecutive days. Beginning on the 6th day, Best Cremation Care will charge \$100 for each additional day of refrigeration.
